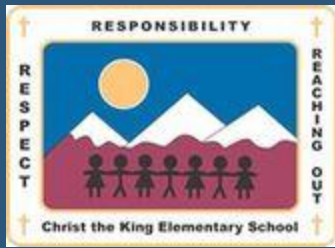
VI. Principal's Report – Jeanette

#### X. Sports Day – June 15<sup>th</sup>

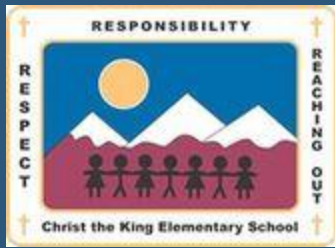
- Teachers interested in school council hosting a bbq for students
