#### RPAY Action Grant

CKES Council's application was recently approved, and we have received a Recreation and Parks Association of Yukon (RPAY) Action Grant for \$500. The money is to be used to increase opportunities for physical activity for children during the school day. The school will use the money to purchase Badminton nets, badminton rackets and an equipment storage cart.

## Christmas Celebration

Our Christmas Celebration will be on Thursday, December 19, 2013. There will be 2 shows again this year, one at 1:30pm and one at 7:00pm.

Each student has already received two (2) passes for their family to attend the celebration in the evening. Extra passes for the evening show may be available starting on December 2nd. The same celebration will be performed

in the afternoon as well, and will be open to anyone who wishes to attend.

In past years, concerns were brought forward by parents to the Fire Marshall about the number of people who were in attendance. The number of people at the evening celebration is now limited.

If families do not need all the passes given to them, *please* return passes to the school so they can be available for other families to access.

We are always pleased that everyone is so supportive of this special event and that it is so well attended, but we do need to address the safety requirements.

Due to this safety issue, if passes are lost, we cannot replace them. Your name will have to go on the wait-list for more tickets if they become available. Please remember to bring your passes to the celebration - you can not get in without them! Thank you for your understanding.



## School Seismic Evaluation

In 2010, following recommendations from the Auditor General, the Department of Highways and Public Works (HPW) began screening high priority public buildings for hazards. This began Phase 1 of a four phase Seismic Mitigation program. Eight schools, including Christ the King Elementary School, were identified by the screening as being at elevated seismic risk and required further study.

For Phase 2, HPW commissioned a detailed engineering report which was received in September. Since then, staff at HPW and Education have reviewed the report and prepared Phase 3. During this phase, Education will improve training to teachers, students and staff to ensure everybody knows exactly what to do in an earthquake. CKES already completes earthquake drills with its students, and a new earthquake guidebook will be distributed in the spring.

The Department of Education will also go through the school and identify non-structural risks which are of immediate concern (i.e. attach shelving to walls, etc.) and have this work undertaken shortly. This mediation work will happen on holidays, evenings and school closed days, in order to cause as little disruption to classes as possible.

Phase 4 will examine structural aspects of our school building and prepare plans for reducing any structural concerns.

At the School Council meeting on November 5, we met with Dr. Albert Trask, Assistant Deputy Minister of Public Schools, who provided us with further information on this issue. Dr. Trask noted that the Whitehorse area is in the low area in terms of seismic zones and that the risk scenario is also low for our school.

  January 2.

The Yukon Teachers Association will be consulting separately with teaching staff on the school calendar.
