

Cold Weather Policy and Polar Bear Club initiative



<u>Polar Bear Club</u>: This is a new initiative the school is trying out this winter. The Polar Bear Club is for students who would like to go out for fresh air and play, instead of having an inside recess during cold weather days. <u>It is OPTIONAL</u> and students will need parental permission to join. The Teacher Leader will go out with the students to supervise and ensure the safety of Club members. Students who do join the Club, and go outside for recess will be allowed back in to the school at anytime, if they get cold or uncomfortable. If they choose to go inside early, they must go to their classroom for the remainder of the recess. If a student joins Polar Bear Club, but doesn't feel like going outside with the Club one day, they may choose to stay inside.
