Drop-off Safety Concerns

PLEASE DO NOT DROP STUDENTS OFF AT THE GRADE 2/3 OR 4/5 SIDE OF THE SCHOOL. This driveway is not on school property. The driveway was plowed after our last large snowfall by mistake – we have asked that it not be plowed in the future. It is not meant to be used by the school staff or parents. Currently, it is very unsafe for students who are playing in that area in the mornings, and very difficult for supervisors to watch for cars and students.

Instead, please drop students off on the sidewalk of Nisultin Drive between the driveway and the school bus lane. Students can walk along the sidewalk to the school entrance and then to their proper entryways.

FYI, parking and drop-off upgrades are planned for CKES this summer. We very much look forward to having more efficient and accessible parking at CKES in the future!
