Dear Christ the King students and families,

We have some updates regarding our Covid mitigations here at CKES:

Re-useable masks are being sent home today:

Yukon Education has provided one re-useable mask for each student in grades 4-7. These masks will be distributed to students Friday afternoon. Each mask has been labeled with the student's class and initials, in hopes of keeping each person's mask to themselves! Please remember:

1. Wash before first use. Wash in hot water with like colours.
2. Before putting on any mask, clean your hands.
3. Cover your mouth and nose with the mask and ensure there are no gaps. Masks that are too large can be adjusted by tying small knots in each elastic to make it tighter to the face.
4. Avoid touching the mask when wearing it. Wash / sanitize your hands if you do touch it.
5. Replace the mask when it gets damp.
6. When removing the mask, remove it by using the elastics, not the fabric.

These masks are now students' personal property. We ask each student to be responsible with mask use. Students may already have other masks – it does not matter which one they use. We do request that students always have a mask available at school.

Again, masks are recommended for use when we are outside of our "bubbles" and less than two metres apart. They are not mandatory.

Do not send food for sharing to school

I am saddened to be required to ask that families do not send food to school beyond your own student's lunches. We understand that sharing food is a way of celebrating special events. However, we must follow our established health and safety plan, which includes not sharing food among students. Thank you for understanding.
