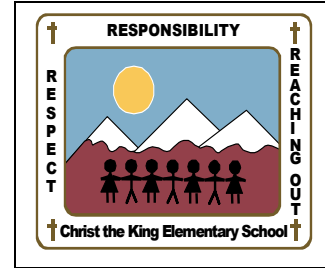


## June 2026 CKES Chronicle
